Assign each student a motif—a "theme" or an actual object—that they track throughout their reading of the novel and then give a small presentation and/or write a short paper analyzing their findings. They might consider questions such as: What seems to be the function of this motif in *A Mercy*? How (if at all) does Morrison's representation of the motif change throughout the novel? Does the motif change in chapters told by different characters, and if so, why?
